  - Is committed to using data for improvement


#### **Survey Respondents**

84% overall "percent of target" rate



### Student Respondent Profile: First-Generation Status



## Student Respondent Profile: Goals




### Student Respondent Profile: Total Credit Hours Earned

### Student Respondent Profile: External Commitments




### CCSSE Benchmarks for Effective Educational Practice
