# SPRING 2021 "TRANSITION QUARTER"

# the plan:

LTCC currently offers a variety of classes primarily online, with a few exceptions. This is to keep students, faculty, and staff as safe as possible while our country continues to grapple with a pandemic. LTCC understands that many of our students wish to be back on campus, enjoying face-to-face classes while participating in events, student clubs, and all that contributes to a rich college experience. All of us at LTCC wish for this too. Until COVID-19 is under control and the state clears the way for widescale, indoors education at California's community colleges, LTCC will primarily provide education virtually.

LTCC is striving to reopen crucial student support areas on campus such as the library and computer lab before students return to the classroom. Our ability to do this is also dependent on COVID-19 and being able to assure student safety. A final determination about Spring quarter 12-week classes and how they will be delivered will be made the week of March 15, 2021.

made the week of April 19, 2021. You'll notice many more face-to-face classes offered in Spring quarter. LTCC's ability to host these is contingent on COVID being under control, and our students' and faculty safety being assured. While LTCC will do everything we can to hold these classes face-to-face, students who register for them now need to know that conditions may force us to cancel them, or move them to a hybrid or fully online modality, depending on COVID-19. It is a fluid situation, and we recommend students check this online Course Schedule regularly to see if the classes you've registered for will be

- Wear your face mask and maintain social distancing of at least 6 feet at all times inside LTCC's facilities



# REFUNDS

LTCC's policy on refunds applies to fees charged for credit classes including enrollment fees, non-resident tuition, material fees, and facility use fees. Students must initiate a refund request. Refunds can take up to 15 business days to process if fees were paid by check.

Canceled Classes: All funds are fully refundable if LTCC cancels a class.

**Dropped Classes:** If a student chooses to drop a class before it starts, all fees are refundable with a few exceptions. To receive a refund on or after a class starts, the drop must happen by:

- 12-week classes: Friday of the 2nd week of the class
- 6-week classes: Friday of the 1st week of the class
- All other classes: Drop prior to the 10% point of the class, determined by calendar days
- Art material fees: If a student drops an Art class after receiving materials, refunds will be pro-rated based on the amount of materials used

Health & Student Representation Fees: Refundable if all classes are dropped before the refund deadline for 12-week classes.

**Field Trips & Optional Fees:** Refunds are possible if the drop is made two weeks before the first class meeting. After this, refunds are only possible if the student dropping can be replaced by another student who registers and pays all fees. This is not guaranteed.

**Service Fees:** Most are non-refundable. These are fees for challenge exams, transcripts, replacement diplomas, replacement certificates, and similar.

# **CLASS FORMATS**

# **Enhanced Virtual Education (EVE)**

LTCC offers traditional distant education (DE) courses that provide independent learning and flexibility. For students who wish to have a face-to-face educational experience but in the safest way possible during COVID-19, LTCC offers Enhanced Virtual Education, or EVE.



Like traditional DE, EVE classes are also offered online and use the Canvas system for base information and resources, but they also use Zoom as well as other technologies to provide more "real time" contact. EVE classes are different than DE – they are intentionally designed for students who prefer a face-to-face classroom feel. In EVE classes, you'll experience:

- A high-touch environment with extra support
- Labs offered in a virtual environment
- Lots of discussion and interaction with your teacher and fellow students
- Use of video for visual learning
- One-on-one support from faculty, including virtual office hours
- Discussions, interactions, projects with faculty and other students offered in "real-time"
- Some synchronous elements offered during the scheduled course days and times
- Other asynchronous elements/course content moved to a virtual environment

#### What does this mean for me?

You should plan to be available during the times and days listed on the schedule. While the instructor may not use the full time, this is time set aside for synchronous digital learning. Reach out to your instructor with any specific instructions on class timing.

# Face-to-Face (F2F)

Traditional learning will be re-introduced in **Spring 2021**, allowing students to be on campus in an in-person classroom environment. Classrooms and all common areas of campus will be thoroughly cleaned and santized reguarly. Please note that should anything change with the pandemic, F2F classes will move to the EVE format.

#### What does this mean for me?

Limited face-to-face courses will be offered in Spring. If you enroll in a F2F course, please ensure that you are available during the days and times listed, and be prepared to come to campus or report to your off-campus location for those courses.

#### **ASYNCHRONOUS**

learning doesn't necessarily happen at the same time for instructor and students; classwork often consists of independent reading, prerecorded video watching, and other tasks students complete on their own.

### **SYNCHRONOUS**

learning happens in real time between your instructor and your class either face-to-face, or via Canvas, Zoom, or other virtual spaces. Classwork deadlines are often scheduled on consistent days/times, providing structure for those who prefer that.

# **Hybrid**

There are some LTCC courses that cannot be entirely duplicated in an online virtual format. These typically involve courses where receiving and demonstrating hands-on knowledge and training are required. These courses usually involve public safety work and are often found in the Allied Health, Fire and EMT, and Wilderness Education and Outdoor Leadership departments. Other courses in Culinary Arts, 3D Arts, and the various sciences also have offerings in a hybrid format in order for students to practice key hands-on skills.

The F2F components of these hybrid courses will only be provided if they meet current state and federal guidelines regarding COVID-19. Hybrid classes will have limited student participation in a F2F format at a single point in time to increase safety. Campus labs will be thoroughly cleaned and sanitized regularly. Many labs will also take place outdoors.

#### What does this mean for me?

You should plan to come to campus or report to your off-campus location during some of the dates and times listed in the schedule. Usually, the lab or field experience component of the course will take place face-to-face, while the lecture component will be virtual through Zoom.

# **Distance Education**

Traditional learning will be re-introduced in **Spring 2021**, allowing students to be on campus in an in-person classroom environment. Classrooms and all common areas of campus will be thoroughly cleaned and santized reguarly. Please note that should anything change with the pandemic, F2F classes will move the EVE format.

#### What does this mean for me?

These courses are fully online and offer asynchronous learning. There are no specific days or times associated with these courses.
