Hello students,

We're writing with some updates, links, and information we hope will better inform you about what Spring quarter at LTCC will be like, and how you can get help right now to continue your education successfully.

Spring classes begin Monday, April 6 with students and faculty learning, sharing, and talking together in a virtual environment. Support services to help you are available online. These include counseling, tutoring, help with the Canvas online portal, and all Enrollment Services functions such as registration. For more on these resources, visit www.ltcc.edu/virtualcampus.

LTCC is moving toward **Enhanced Virtual Education, or EVE**. What this means is that while face-to-face classes are moving to a virtual format, you will still experience what LTCC is best known for: great one-on-one support with a high-touch, personalized approach from college faculty and staff. Your classes will still include a lot of discussion and interaction with your instructors and fellow students. Video will be incorporated to assist visual learning. Zoom office hours for extra help with teachers will be available. It's not exactly face to face, but EVE goes a long way toward allowing you to learn the way you like.

Don't assume the F2F classes you're interested in won't be offered! The majority of LTCC's **scheduled face-to-face classes for Spring are moving to virtual**. We are working on transitioning science labs to a virtual learning environment, along with many art, culinary arts, Fire Academy and EMT, music, and physical education classes, among others. Team sport classes and some Wilderness Education field courses will be canceled, but much of what else we have listed in our schedule (www.ltcc.edu/schedule) will be offered online – so register today!
