Subject: Closure Details: FEC, locker rooms, and G3

Dear Students,

Lake Tahoe Community College is cancelling some physical fitness classes and closing parts of campus related to athletics.

As of now, the **Fitness Education Center in the Physical Education building is closed** until further notice. **Classroom G3 is also closed** and most classes held there will be rescheduled to the Dance Studio in the PE building.

All non-credit fitness classes and student athletic club events are canceled.

For-credit PEF classes will still meet, but will be lecture only - no physical activity or equipment will be used and social distancing measures will be in effect. Finals for PEF classes take place next week (March 16-20) with these measures in place.

Men's and women's locker rooms in the PE Building must be cleared out immediately. They will be closed starting at 5pm Tuesday, March 17.

The college is taking these actions because of the higher likelihood of viral spread in closed environments with a significant number of high-touch equipment and surfaces, like fitness rooms. These measures are preventative: there currently are no confirmed cases of COVID-19 in El Dorado County. Taking steps like this will help to stop the spread of the virus and keep students, staff and the community safer.
