Student Government Elections:

Dear Coyotes,

In difficult times like these, LTCC's Student Senate is looking for thoughtful, passionate, and organized individuals to serve as officers next year. Yes, this message is an invitation to ALL students who are interested in running for a position that provides them with the opportunity to represent their classmates and influence how the college functions.

Why else should you run for a position on the Student Senate? Not only will you make decisions that affect students at LTCC and develop your leadership skills, but you will also bond with your peers and gain valuable experience that makes you more attractive to universities you may transfer to, and to future employers.

Here are the positions that we need to fill along with a description of their responsibilities:

President:

this person prepares meeting agendas, facilitates meetings, represents the college on a statewide level, communicates with advisors and administrators, assists with event planning, and oversees on-campus Student Senate events.

Vice President: this person attends meetings, assists the Student Senate president and other officers with activities, serves on different subcommittees, and presides over meetings as needed.

Public Affairs Officer: this person attends meetings and monitors and informs the Student Senate about any relevant legislative changes from all levels of government that affect students.

Treasurer:

this person attends meetings, monitors the Student Senate's financial records, and plays a direct role in fundraising activities.

Activities Officer: this person attends meetings and oversees Student Senate events, including those that require a budget and publicity.

Public Relations Officer: this person is responsible for surveying students to determine their concerns and preparing content for the Student Senate page on the college's website.

Secretary:

this person records the minutes from regular Student Senate meetings and communicates with different student clubs that are active on campus.

Student Trustee: this person represents the Student Senate by attending LTCC Board of Trustees meetings and reporting back to the senate what is happening on a collegewide level.

Parliamentarian: this person ensures that the Student Senate follows its own constitution and bylaws as well as state law when conducting its meetings, and oversees Student Senate elections in the spring.

To serve, you must be enrolled in at least 8 units of coursework this coming Fall Quarter 2020 and hold a minimum 2.0 GPA. Also, please note that these positions pay a \$100 stipend per quarter.
