



Veteran Affairs Supportive Housing (VASH) Program for El Dorado County Veterans

Services:

The Office of Housing and Urban Development (HUD) has awarded the Public Housing Authority of El Dorado County rental assistance vouchers for administration of the HUD-VASH (Veteran Affairs Supportive Housing) program. The HUD-VASH program **provides rental housing assistance to qualified Homeless Veterans** throughout El Dorado County in conjunction with case management services provided through the Veterans Affairs Northern California Health Care System. The program is designed to support homeless veterans and their families in finding and maintaining affordable permanent housing.

Who Qualifies?

This program was designed to address the needs of the most vulnerable homeless veterans. To be eligible for the program, veterans must be eligible for VA medical services, homeless and be willing to participate in case management services. Income and other eligibility requirements apply.
