APPLY TO LTCC

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STEPS TO GET STARTED



New Students, Returning Students, and Transfer Students

APPLY TO LTCC online at www.ltcc.edu/admissions

- On the ADMISSIONS page, click on ONLINE APPLICATION.
- <u>STEP 1</u>: Create an OpenCCC Account. <u>STEP 2</u>: Begin the application process. Click on 'Begin Application'.
- Allow 2 (business) days for the application to be processed and then you will receive an email with your Student ID number.

APPLY FOR FINANCIAL AID

- To apply for financial aid, <u>STEP 1</u>: Students and parents, are required to create a FSA ID, <u>STEP 2</u>: Complete the Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA) at www.FAFSA.ed.gov.
- Complete and return all requested documents sent to your student email.
- California residents may qualify for the Board of Governors Fee Waiver (BOG); visit the One-Stop Office for more information or call extension 236.

ORIENTATION - ASSESSMENTS - ADVISING

Visit the *One-Stop Office*, A102, or call (530) 541-4660 ext. 211 for assistance. Check the current quarterly schedule or visit the LTCC website for up-to-date dates and times.

ATTEND ORIENTATION and COMPLETE ASSESSMENT

- Orientation sessions are 2½ hours long and at various times and dates.
- Assessment testing is on a drop-in basis located in room D121.
 - o Bring a photo ID and LTCC student ID number.
 - o The math assessment is a timed 45 minute test.
- For English placement, please bring your high school/ college transcripts or AP, SAT, ACT, or EAP test scores when you meet with a counselor.

ASSESSMENT EXEMPTIONS:

- Returning students that previously completed assessments
- Transfer students (completed 30 semester/45 quarter units at another college)

MEET WITH A COUNSELOR

- Initial appointments should be scheduled after orientation and assessment have been completed.
- When you meet with a counselor you'll discuss your placement results, select the courses that are right for you, and create an educational plan.
- Please bring a copy of any previous course work to discuss course planning.

REGISTER FOR CLASSES

- Check your registration priority time in the quarterly schedule to register early.
- Register for classes in person at the One-Stop or online through passport.
- Payment of registration fees is required at the time of registration.
- ** STUDENT PORTAL— PASSPORT: https://portal.ltcc.edu/ Username is the first letter of your first name, first letter of your middle name (skip if you don't have a middle name) and your entire last name —Example: bhanderson *Username is a ten-character maximum. Password: Lt + your six-digit date of birth (ex. March 15, 1965 would be Lt031565). Your LTCC email address is: [username]@mail.ltcc.edu. Can't log in? Call the One-Stop Office for assistance.
- STUDENT ID CARD: After registering, take your class schedule to the library to obtain a free LTCC Student ID card.
