Call to Order

I. Discussion and Reports

- A. LTCCD General Obligation Bond Campaign Update (Murillo) Dr. Murillo reported \$51,590 is committed to the Measure F Campaign. All but \$6,000 has been collected from pledges. The campaign has generated a great deal of support and acknowledged those working on the campaign.
- B. 2014 Taste of Gold Event Update (DeFranco/Booth) The date was recommended to stay consistent with previous years and staff was encouraged to book the Josh Pfeiffer Band for 2015. Staff should build in a budget to purchase wine and food if needed and bring this item back to the next regular meeting for further discussion.
- C. LTCC Friends of Soccer Club Update (DeFranco/Booth) The Foundation sponsored alongside with the Classic Cue the LTCC Coyote's soccer team's first double header home game on October 3rd. More than 300 spectators came to the event and a great deal of appreciation and recognition to the LTCC Foundation and the Friends of Soccer Club. A great deal of friend-raising has been taking place in an effort to raise supporters of the college and the intercollegiate soccer program.

Discussion circulating the need for a retreat to understand the overall direction on how to proceed with timing and logistics regarding events, expenditures and how a retreat will be scheduled at the beginning of the new year. Staff will bring this to the November meeting as an action item.

D. 2014/15 Annual Student Success Campaign (Booth) Julie will review old contact lists found in Melonie's files and send to the Board members for review and updates. The annual campaign contacts will also be sent to the entire board for review, and to make personal touches to community members and donors alerting them of the campaign.
