The role of the LTCC International program is to:


- help students navigate the American education system





2017/2018 – 2022/2023 ACADEMIC YEARS







2017/2018 – 2022/2023 ACADEMIC YEARS**





2017/2018 – 2022/2023 ACADEMIC YEARS**



Successfully completed the I-17 recertification with SEVIS in 2017, 2020, and 2022 (which enables LTCC to continue hosting international students) as well as the SEVP approval process to add 9 new academic majors and the English Proficiency Pathway program


