




Rising Scholars Program Student Enrollment





Scholars Program 1.0 Grant

\$560,000 Over 3 Years

- In 2018, the State of California committed to serving incarcerated and formerly incarcerated students through one-time funding of \$5 million, resulting in 44 grants to California Community Colleges.
- In 2021, the State furthered its commitment to serving this population of students with a \$10 million ongoing allocation in the 2021 State Budget Act and the passage of Assembly Bill 417 (McCarty, 2021), which established the Rising Scholars Network as a categorically funded program.



Juvenile Justice Expansion

Grant \$ 1,545,454.00 Over 5 Years In alignment with AB417, SB716 and the CEO/Board goals is for LTCC's RSP to expand access to education for currently and formerly incarcerated/detained students face-to-face and at a distance.
