Program Updates:

- -The Business department has been showing consistent FTES
- -Slightly up in enrollments
- -Few cancelled courses
- -Strategic planning of courses and modalities have proven to help students complete certificates and degrees in a timely manner
- -Enhanced Virtual Education modality has given more flexibility to students to complete courses
- -Student diversity: Females are slightly higher represented, Hispanic representation has increased over the years; 25-49 age range takes majority.
- -High success rates in the Business department, one of the strongest departments in terms of degrees/certificates awarded

Member Updates:

- -General discussion debating the pros and cons of online courses vs. face-to-face courses.
- -Discussion of teaching and learning challenges during the pandemic- how has it impacted the business world?
- -Some face-to-face services are opening up to students on a limited schedule at the college; library, enrollment services
- -Efforts to increase student success include access to internet, Chromebook rentals, zero textbook costs
- -Guided Pathways provides a map for students to see what classes to take, what professions could be options, salary rates, graduation timeline, etc.
- -In looking at the Hospitality degree, there was feedback and discussion on how a Marketing course would be beneficial
- -Introduction to the Purple Briefcase partnership, a way to connect employers with possible employees. Also allows students to do mock interviews and skill development.
