## Welcome to the Intensive Spanish Summer Institute (ISSI)

Lake Tahoe Community College supports advanced placement of students currently enrolled in grades 9-12, who have clearly demonstrated the ability to profit from college level course work, and who possess the maturity level required to function in an adult educational environment. Special admission is allowed upon approval to high school students who wish to enroll in advanced scholastic or vocational education. Follow these easy steps to ensure your success in enrolling for college-level courses.

Registration	High school students may register online if your college placement form is received at least 2 business days before you intend to register. You may mail the completed form to LTCC, fax it to 530-542-1781, or submit a scanned PDF to enrollmentservices@ltcc.edu. If you prefer not to register online, complete your registration paperwork and submit to Admissions & Records in person or by mail. Registration forms are not accepted via fax.	
Fees	Pay your fees when you register. Enrollment is only complete upon full payment of fees and/or tuition. If your fees are not paid, you will be dropped from your courses for non-payment.	
Switching/ ISSI Levels	6 IMPORTANT! Please make sure you choose the correct level. High school students can <u>not</u> switch levels without college placement forms signed by their high school indicating the new course(s). Courses fill up quickly and it is usually <u>not</u> possible to switch levels once the Institute has begun.	
ISSI Packet	7 You will receive an ISSI packet in the mail. Follow this packet for the correct time and location of each course and breakout session.	
LTCC Transcripts	If you need an official copy of your transcript showing your ISSI grades, please submit a transcript request at Admissions & Records. Transcripts will be mailed approximately three weeks after ISSI ends.	

**Reminder!** If you plan to take additional courses at LTCC or attend ISSI in the future, you will need to update your status once you graduate from high school. Please bring a copy of your diploma or a transcript showing your graduation date to the Admissions & Records office. We will update your records to remove the special admission status. This change will allow you to register online in the future.

## **Important Note for Parents**

Once your child enrolls in <u>college</u>, all privacy rights regarding your child's educational records transfer to your child <u>regardless of his or her age</u>. This means that your child will be treated the same as other college students.

- He/she will be expected to sign all forms requiring a student signature. Parents can not sign for the student.
- He/she will be asked to provide the college with a <u>signed</u> release to have specific information from their educational records (such as grades) released to you.
