2025–2026 Independent Student Verification Worksheet

Your 2025–2026 Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA) was selected by the Department of Education for review in a process called verification. The law says that before awarding Federal Student Aid, we must ask you to confirm the information you reported on your FAFSA. To verify that you provided correct information, our financial aid office staff will compare your FAFSA with the information on this worksheet and with any other required documents. If there are differences, your FAFSA information may need to be corrected. You must complete all applicable sections and sign this worksheet, attach any required documents, and submit the form and other required documents to the Financial Aid Office at Lake Tahoe Community College. We cannot award you federal financial aid until verification is complete.
