- STEPS TO GET STARTED AT LTCC -

New, Returning and Transfer Students

APPLY TO LTCC <u>www.ltcc.edu/apply</u>

- On the ENROLLMENT webpage, select your admissions track and APPLY. <u>STEP 1:</u> Create an OpenCCC Account or login in. <u>STEP 2:</u> Begin the application by signing in.
- Allow 2 (business) days for the application to be processed and then you will receive an email with your Student ID number.

COMPLETE FINANCIAL AID

- To apply for financial aid, students (and parents), are required to create a FSA ID then complete the Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA) at <u>fafsa.gov</u> or complete the CA Dream Act Application at <u>dream.csac.ca.gov</u>
- Complete and return all requested documents sent to your student email through <u>Passport</u>.
- California residents may qualify for the <u>California College Promise Grant Fee Waiver</u> (CCPG), formally known as the BOG Fee Waiver.

ORIENTATION - COUNSELING - EDUCATIONAL PLAN

Complete the interactive online orientation at www.ltcc.edu/orientation

- All new students are required to complete an orientation unless they are taking courses for personal enrichment, enhancing job skills, maintaining a certificate or license, completing credits for high school, or have already received an Associate degree or higher.
- Initial appointments with any LTCC counselor can be scheduled at <a href="https://licen.com/ltcs.com
- An Educational Plan is like a personal road map that you develop with a counselor and required for all students with a degree goal or goal of transfer. The "map" lays out the courses you should complete quarter by quarter in order to successfully reach your educational goal.

REGISTER AND ENROLL FOR CLASSES

- Check your registration priority time in the guarterly schedule to register early.
- Register for classes in person at Enrollment Services or online through <u>Passport</u>.
- Payment of fees is required at the time of registration.
- STUDENT PORTAL- PASSPORT: https://portal.ltcc.edu/ Username is the first letter of your first name, first letter of your middle name (skip if you don't have a middle name) and your entire last name -Example: bhanderson *Username is a ten-character maximum. Password: Lt + your six-digit date of birth (ex. March 15, 1965 would be Lt031565). Your LTCC email address is: [username]@mail.ltcc.edu. Can't log in? Call the Student Services for assistance.
